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A) Discussions and Deliberations

Details	
1)	<p>The chairperson, Dr. T N Sreenivasa welcomed the members present.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Resolution 1</u></b></p> <p>All the faculty members must implement active Learning methods to engage the classes and document the same on Quiklrn platform.</p> <p>The IQAC head confirmed that the implementation of active Learning methods is in progress on Quiklrn platform.</p> <p>The other actions taken are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Research center for Physics is approved from 2022-23 by VTU and is a part of affiliation notification dated 14<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2022</li> <li>The faculty members are trained in active learning methods through the Teaching-Learning Cell and are executed through the Quiklrn platform.</li> <li>The faculty members are informed to break the class every 15 to 20 minutes and conduct short activities like Poll, Think-Pair-Share, Quiz etc.</li> <li>A few MOOC (Massive Open Online Courses) like NPTEL, Coursera, Udacity etc. is made compulsory for "A" category of students, wherever possible.</li> <li>An MoU is signed with ComedKares launched by COMEDK (Consortium of Medical, Engineering and Dental Colleges of Karnataka) to Help Engineering Students Stay up to date on new and emerging technology skills.</li> <li>First year students of 2021-22 batch (BSc (Hons) are undergoing internship in ComedKares-Yelahanka branch.</li> <li>The VTU curriculum of 2022-23 batch is in line with NEP 2020, the faculty handling first year will be undergoing training conducted by VTU in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics which is application based specific to different programs.</li> <li>The internship for four weeks starts right from first year.</li> <li>To improve the quality of publication, the Institution has implemented incentive scheme to motivate the faculty members to spend quality time on research.</li> <li>The Placement officer has organised TPO-HR meeting at Radisson Atria for networking and improving placements in August 2022.</li> </ol>
2)	<p>The Principal informed 100% admission should be done for the academic year 2022-23. Extra efforts to be extended by the department of MBA as the intake are increased from 60 to 120.</p> <p>The intake of ME and CV has been reduced to 60. The Heads of Mechanical and Civil departments were informed to continue the branding programs to attract the candidates to take up admission as there are very few takers.</p> <p>The IQAC head said that, as listed in the action taken above, the implementation of the gaming activities for Teaching-Learning will be implemented from the first year (2022-23 batch) on wards.</p> <p>Furthermore the Head, IQAC informed the members present that few changes are proposed in the CO attainment; the faculty can have different target for each CO, based on the complexity of the concepts covered under the COs. It is left to the department to decide and fix the target. The same was agreed by the members.</p> <p>The Principal informed that this can be implemented from the current Academic year (2022-23).</p> <p>The feedback analysis and the corrective measures taken were briefed to the Members.</p> <p>The results of 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> semesters were discussed.</p> <p>To improve the results, the HoDs were asked to adopt ways to encourage learning among the slow learners.</p>
3)	<p>The placement data of last three years including the current year was presented, the number of students placed is very low compared to previous years.</p> <p>Mr. Santhosh C, the Alumni/Industry coordinator said that the recession has started in IT industries, the recruitment is drastically slowed down. He said that multi-disciplinary projects and training in new technology skill can help in placing students.</p> <p>The Principal informed the Placement officer to have discussion with the students department wise along with HoDs and Placement coordinators to find out the training requirements and assistance required by the students to improve placements.</p>



4) As decided in the previous meeting, the Dean Research is conducting regular reviews on Research activities. The Researchers are utilizing the seed money of one lakh per Researcher for Research work.

5) Accreditation:  
The Principal informed that NBA accreditation results were announced and four UG programs (ECE, CSE, ISE and ME) and one PG program (MBA) are accredited up to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025. The details of score is appended below:
