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Proceedings:

- 1. Dr. T N Sreenivasa, Principal, Atria Institute of Technology greeted all the members present online & offline and welcomed each one of them.
- 2. The proceedings of the Governing Council Meeting held on 30th April 2022 was reviewed and **action taken** are as under:
 - a. To attract the companies with higher packages, the management has proposed to bear the complete charges to provide company specific training to the students. The Placement officer is working on the requirements.
 - b. Two faculty members from the Leadership group (IQAC head and BSE HoD) are identified to undergo a course on Teaching-Learning offered by IUCEE, so that the knowledge sharing can be done through the Teaching-Learning Center.
 - c. The faculty members are informed to assist the students to increase the number of students taking MOOC courses.
 - d. The Institute has planned to sign an MoU with the ComedKares launched by COMEDK (Consortium of Medical, Engineering and Dental Colleges of Karnataka) to Help Engineering Students Stay up to date on new and emerging technology skills.
 - e. The faculty members are informed to concentrate on Quality publications (Q1/Q2) as it is one of the major requirements of Accreditation and Ranking.
- 3. The Principal presented the activities at the Institution level for the last four months (May to August 2022). Subsequently, the HoDs spoke about the achievements of their respective departments.
- 4. The Principal informed that NBA accreditation results were announced and four UG programs (ECE, CSE, ISE and ME) and one PG program (MBA) are accredited up to 30th June 2025. The details of score is appended below:

- 5. The members congratulated the efforts of all the staff members for their contribution in achievement of NBA accreditation.
- 6. The members went through the peer team report and said that we need to strengthen the total Research area including grants and consultancy.
- 7. The Vision and Mission of the department of MCA was discussed, the committee approved the same with minor corrections.
- 8. The Principal said that in order to encourage the students performances, the Alumni has come up with a proposal to start "Alumni Scholarship" for the toppers in each branch semester wise. The same will be awarded during the Mega-Alumni meet conducted on the third Saturday of December every year. The members appreciated the initiative.
- 9. The members said that the performance indicators like result, placement, student publication will automatically improve if the student of higher ranking are admitted to the college.
- 10. The principal said that we are also organizing a greater number of outreach programs and trying for maximum social connect through Linkedin, Facebook, Instagram etc. to improve branding. The scholarship scheme discussed in the previous meeting is being implemented.
- 11. The residential Induction Program is planned with additional new activities compared the previous one. As per the suggestion of the Hon. Chairman, Shri. C S Sunder Raju, we will be extending the induction program to Comed-K and CET students in addition to the Management students of the 2022-23 batch.
- 12. The highlights of the concluding remarks by the GC members were:
 - a) Prepare the faculty to adopt and implement NEP, provide awareness.
 - b) Train the faculty rigorously in Teaching-Learning.
 - c) Try for A++ in NAAC accreditation Cycle-2.
 - d) Improve ARIIA and NIRF ranking.
 - e) Improve quality of admission intake.
