

3.4.1 Extension activities are carried out in the neighborhood community, sensitizing students to social issues, for their holistic development, and impact thereof during the last five years.

Atria Institute of Technology strives for a holistic and value-based education for the students. In view of this, it organizes and participates in various extension activities to promote the College Neighborhood-Community network. It promotes the students to establish contact with the neighborhood communities and interact with them to explore the opportunities for social work. Major emphasis is given on student engagement, service orientation, and the holistic development of students which further contributes to their development as good citizen of the country. The extension activities are conducted in association with National Service Scheme, various Clubs, and societies of the institution.

As part of extension activities students at the institute are encouraged to guide and tutor underprivileged studying in the Government school. Students at the institute organize various extra-curricular activities in association with institute clubs for the underprivileged students.

The institute organizes voluntary blood donation camps within campus every year where our students, faculty and outside participants wholeheartedly participate in the activity. The mass participation of students and faculty shows their inner values of harmony and mercy. The institute has organized RT-PCR test twice for students, teaching, non-teaching staffs and outsiders during the pandemic. The institute arranged for vaccination drive for first and second dose of Covid vaccination for students, teaching, non-teaching staffs and outsiders. Both the events saw huge participation.
