The total resources and activities of the Library are summarized below.




Fig. 1: Resources and Activities of Library

The highlights of ILMS are summarized below.




Fig. 2: Summary of ILMS

**Digital Library:** The Institute library has a Digital Library which provides access to digital resources. IP based authenticated access has been provided. 28 computers are available with LAN connectivity.

Library has a collection of 106 NPTEL CDs and 1746 Books CDs.

### **Subscription to e- resources:**

The Institute library is a member of **VTU e - Consortium and DELNET** (Developing Library Network). Users can access e- resources publisher wise / Conference proceedings / author title / year of publication / Digital Object Identifier (DOI) etc. It can be accessed anywhere at any time. 


Fig. 4: Library Collections
